Admission of Students

Students shall be admitted to the school district who are:

- legal residents of the school district or otherwise entitled by Nebraska law to attend the schools of the district tuition-free;
- approved for option enrollment pursuant to policy;
- approved as a foreign exchange student pursuant to policy; or
- legal residents of a district that has contracted with this district for their educational services.
- statutorily entitled to attend the schools of the district on a part-time basis subject to this policy and the regulations of the district; *or*
- out-of-state students who have been enrolled pursuant to policy.

21 Students who have been placed in a foster home within the school district
22 are not residents of the district and will not be permitted to enroll unless the
23 district has received a written determination from the Nebraska
24 Department of Health and Human Services that it is in the best interests of
25 the student not to attend his or her district or residence.

26
27 Except in adult education classes or when otherwise required by law, no
28 student who is of 21 years of age or older, or who has earned a high
29 school diploma or its equivalent will be allowed to be enrolled in or
30 continue to attend school in the district. (this paragraph previously in Board
31 Policy 5003)

32
33 Students who seek to enroll in the district must comply with each board
34 policy, state statute and regulation that applies to their situation. Grade
35 level placement will be determined in accordance with district policy.
